The Little Princess Trust provides free real hair wigs to children and young people, up to 24 years old, who have lost their own hair through cancer treatment or other conditions. They also fund childhood cancer research, searching to find kinder and more effective treatments.

Throughout 2025 we have held a range of fundraising activities; from a Walk for Wigs Summer challenge, to fitness events and staff led silent art auctions. Our staff had opportunity to visit the charity HQ for some volunteering which was an eye opener into all the hard work being the scenes. It has been a privilege for ETL to get to know The Little Princess Trust; their incredible team and the story of the charity's heart felt journey.

What is involved in the Hyrox Race?

The race combines both running and functional workout stations, where participants run 1 km, followed by 1 functional workout station, repeated eight times.



How long have you been training for this?

I have been training for almost an year, with intensity increasing over time. I have 11 full weeks of training ahead that combine 2 Leg workouts, 2 Hyrox classes and 2 runs; one an interval run and another long run.



What is involved in the training?

Training is pretty intense. A lot of focus is on cardio and endurance - 8 km of running, with a functional station every 1 km. In addition, a lot of exercises are to prepare my legs for the race, especially the repetition of standard movements, e.g. wall balls, burpee broad jumps, sandbag lunges etc. Movements on the functional stations have to be done as per the rulebook, so training for this is also key.



What is best and worst part of this fitness challenge?

The best part is to training to complete the race in a good time. It is a mindset. I have a goal that I am working towards and seeing my progress is great! It's also an opportunity to meet people in the sport and learn with them . Alongside this, having the opportunity to raise money for LPT whilst doing it! The worst part is the tiredness. I go to the gym everyday after work and have to train hard. Sometimes my body feels too tired for another day, but I have to keep pushing. It is just difficult to balance – work with training and the apprenticeship that I have also started. I have to be really focused!



Will you be ready for the race?

FOR SURE! It has been intense, but I can see how I have improved in one year. I will know for sure on 28th of September when I do a Hyrox Race Simulation at my local gym!
